

LIGHTS, HORN & WIPERS

Regular checking of all exterior and interior lights including indicator and brake lights, horn and wipers adds to safety.

LOCKS, LATCHES & HINGES

Lubrication of all locks and hinges help prevent seizing and early wear.

FLUID LEVELS

Ensure proper fluid levels on a regular basis: Coolant, automatic transmission and brake fluids, windshield washer, power steering and engine oil.

EXHAUST SYSTEM

Check for leakage, faulty seals, hangers and other damage.

ENGINE AND OIL FILTER

Scheduled oil and filter replacements help prevent excessive wear on your engine and keep the engine cool.

DRIVE BELTS

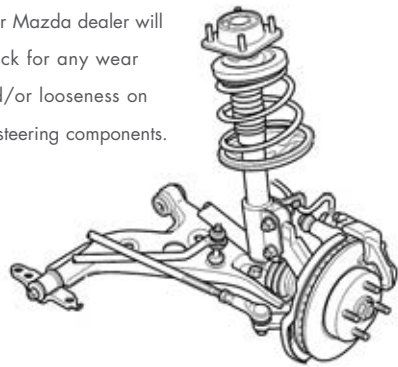
Inspect regularly for wear, cracks and to ensure proper tension.

AIR FILTER

A clean air filter improves your Mazda's performance and fuel economy.

STEERING AND SUSPENSION

Your Mazda dealer will check for any wear and/or looseness on all steering components.



DUST COVERS AND BOOTS

Replace damaged or worn dust covers to help prevent unnecessary wear or replacement of ball joints, CV joints or steering gear.

DISC BRAKES

Effective brake pads create friction to reduce wheel speed, which in turn stops the vehicle. Your Mazda Dealer will inspect and recommend adjusting or replacing worn pads as required.

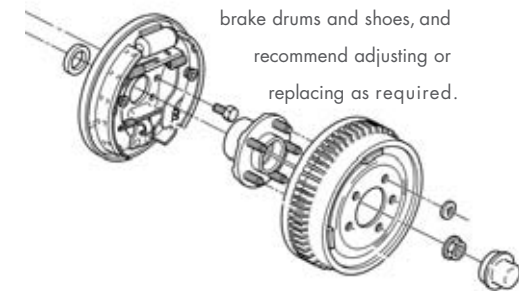


TIRES

Keep your tires inflated to the proper specification and rotate as recommended by the tire manufacturer. Check for abnormal wear or punctures.

DRUM BRAKES

Brake shoes create friction on brake drums to reduce wheel speed, which in turn stops the vehicle. Your Mazda Dealer will check the brake drums and shoes, and recommend adjusting or replacing as required.



Your Mazda Dealer will provide you with a completed service checklist on every maintenance visit. In addition, your Mazda will be road tested after any servicing relating to brakes, steering or driving performance, to help verify safe functioning.
